Aerosol cans  
Asphalt & roofing tar  
Automotive fluids (antifreeze, brake, gas, oil, transmission)  
Batteries (including auto & marine batteries)  
Cleaners & polishes  
Cooking oil (olive, peanut, vegetable, etc.)  
Fertilizers  
Fire extinguishers  
Floor wax & stripper  
Fluorescent bulbs and ballasts (removed from fixture)  
Gasoline  
Kerosene  
Home repair products (glue, caulk, etc.)  
Mercury (thermometers, thermostats, etc.)  
Mothballs  
Nail polish & remover  
Paint (latex, oil-based & spray paint)  
Perfume & cologne  
Pesticides & herbicides  
Photography chemicals  
Poisons  
Propane/butane tanks (20lb. Max.)  
Solvents  
Stains & varnishes  
Sharps (in approved containers, labeled & sealed)  
Smoke detectors  
Wood preservatives
