## **Washtenaw County Dental Clinic Celebrates Three Years**

Enter to win a kids' bike during Children's Dental Health Month

YPSILANTI, Mich., Feb. 22, 2018 – February marks both Children's Dental Health Month and the Washtenaw County Dental Clinic's third anniversary. Since opening, the dental clinic has provided more than 13,000 patient visits to adults and kids with Medicaid or who are uninsured and low income.

The Washtenaw County Dental Clinic is accepting new patients of all ages. It takes most types of Medicaid, MIChild and Healthy Kids and provides low cost dental care to people who are uninsured and low income.

"Outstanding service," said one patient about the dental clinic. "The true care and dedication is unparalleled – everyone in this office is always upbeat and smiling. So refreshing and very greatly appreciated."

The creation of the Washtenaw County Dental Clinic, along with expanded Medicaid coverage, led to 6,700 additional Washtenaw adults and kids with Medicaid receiving dental services in 2015 compared to 2013. Still, only one in two Washtenaw kids, and one in four adults, on Medicaid had any dental exams in 2015 (Michigan Department of Health and Human Services, Medicaid Office).

Children should start dental visits by age one. This creates a positive experience and establishes a dental home before problems arise. Adults should also visit a dentist on a regular basis to prevent oral diseases and maintain their overall health. Oral health has been linked with chronic diseases, including diabetes and heart disease.

To celebrate Children's Dental Health Month, the Washtenaw County Dental Clinic is participating in a sweepstakes that offers children aged ten and under a chance to win a bicycle and helmet.
